NARRATIVE

On 12/7/2023 I Officer Frank was in the area of 450 Auburn when a call came up near Auburn Ave and Hogue St about a female, later identified as Ms. Laneisha Henderson, trying to actively set the Martin Luther King Jr historic house on fire located at 501 Auburn Ave. The 911 callers also stated that they had the female detained and were waiting for police.

Upon my arrival, with the assistance of Officer Stoever and Officer Sanders, we were able to safely transfer Ms. Henderson into our custody with no injuries coming to any of the parties on the scene.

Multiple witnesses were initially on the scene but soon left after Ms. Henderson was placed into our custody. Mr. Zachery Kempf and Mr. Bryce Gardy stayed back to assist with the investigation of the case as they were the first parties on the scene to witness what initially occurred at the location.

Mr. Kempf and Mr. Gardy stated that they were originally from Utah but were down in Atlanta for work and decided to visit the historical monument. They knew the building was closed but just wanted a chance to see the building before heading back to their homes in Utah. When they arrived they noticed a woman in all black pouring what seemed to be water at the time over the bushes. At this moment they didn't think anything of it and proceeded to ask Ms. Henderson if she was upkeeping the plants by watering them but got no response. This is when they proceeded to ask a couple more questions but still got no answer. At this moment in time, they stated their suspicions arose coupled with the fact that the canister she was holding cap fell off in the grass, and instead of looking like a pot for watering plants, it resembled that of a container to hold gas.

When they realized what was going on they started to plead with Ms. Henderson to stop, but she was ignoring them. It also seemed as if she started to rush and pour the gasoline out faster on and around the historical house. They saw no other option but to try to apprehend her, along with the help of other bystanders in the area they tried to get her detained. While trying to detain her they advised that she was actively trying to spark the lighter to the property and bushes so they had to remove it out of her hands and get her under control until police responded.

Ms. Henderson arrived at the location in a black Chevy Cruze FL TAG #X4647 and at the time had all black on with black socks and no shoes during the incident. Multiple cameras were in the area and recorded the incident all relevant videos were uploaded to evidence.com.

Zone 6 Supervisors were notified and Sgt Haslam and Lt Butler arrived on the scene, a perimeter with crime scene tape was set up and a crime scene log was started.

Arson Investigators Capt. Bell and Capt. Douglas along with other Atlanta Fire units were also on scene to assist with the investigation.

Sgt Dorsey and Detective Sluss from Homeland Security arrived at the incident location and aided with the call.

Crime Scene Unit #7331 Hogg processed the scene of the incident location took pictures, and collected all relevant evidence.

National Park Services were notified of the incident/damage that had occurred on their property and sent out units to assist along with the Chief of Interpretation Marty Smith.

Atlanta Chief of Police Schierbaum was also on the scene and assisted with the investigation.

Ms. Henderson was charged with the following charges, 16-7-61 (Criminal Attempt Arson in the 2nd Degree) and 16-7-24 (Interference with Government Property).

Her vehicle was towed by A-tow and escorted to the City of Atlanta Annex by Officer Stoever to be put on hold and processed as evidence at a later date by APD Homeland. Ms. Henderson also had a cell phone on her person which was turned in as evidence by myself.

At the time of this report being written Ms. Henderson is still currently at Grady Memorial Hospital. After being discharged from Grady Memorial Hospital Ms. Henderson will be transported to Fulton County Jail.
