CAUTION

Joanne Chesimard is wanted for escaping from prison in Clinton, New Jersey, while serving a life sentence for murder. On May 2, 1973, Chesimard, who was part of a revolutionary activist organization known as the Black Liberation Army, and two accomplices were stopped for a motor vehicle violation on the New Jersey Turnpike by two troopers with the New Jersey State Police. At the time, Chesimard was wanted for her involvement in several felonies, including bank robbery. Chesimard and her accomplices opened fire on the troopers, seemingly without provocation. One trooper was wounded and the other was shot and killed execution-style at point-blank range. Chesimard fled the scene, but was subsequently apprehended. One of her accomplices was killed in the shoot-out and the other was also apprehended and remains in jail. In 1977, Chesimard was found guilty of first degree murder, assault and battery of a police officer, assault with a dangerous weapon, assault with intent to kill, illegal possession of a weapon, and armed robbery. She was sentenced to life in prison. On November 2, 1979, Chesimard escaped from prison and lived underground before being located in Cuba in 1984. She is thought to currently still be living in Cuba.

Nearly Two Decades Later, Cops Say A Radical Blinded One Of Their Own



Borup took her passion for rioting against Apartheid to a near deadly cause.

In the mid-1970s, a network of fringe groups began pooling resources and intelligence. Many were connected to the Weather Underground, a leftist organization responsible for a series of bombings and riots in protest of the war in Vietnam and racism in the United States.

Factions like the New Freedom Fighters, FALN (a Puerto Rican separatist group) and the "May 19th" communist movement drew a combination of idealists and anti-social misfits.

The FBI JTTF will not speculate about where Donna Jean Borup rates on the spectrum. but by the early 1980s, she was very much on law enforcement's radar.

Born in 1952, the South Amboy, N.J. native stood out for her photographic memory, an IQ of 164, and her ability to speed read.

The FBI JTTF says Borup's sister was associated with the Sandinistas, the socialist party who overthrew Nicaraguan dictator Anastasio Somoza in 1979, and lived in the Central American country.

Borup became an artist, working in design studios, working with layouts, graphics and silk screening. On college campuses and other venues, momentum was building against the United States' relationship with institutions linked to South Africa's racist apartheid government, and Borup apparently devoted herself to the cause.

She always maintained secrecy, and the FBI JTTF theorizes that she's either living in the United States or Canada, where could have worked as an artist.



An Unprovoked Attack at JFK

Police say Borup's crime did not get much attention because of the overall social unrest surrounding the country.

On September 26, 1981, Evan Goodstein, a police officer with the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey – the interstate agency overseeing metropolitan airports, the World Trade Center and other sites – was on a routine assignment at John F. Kennedy Airport in Queens.

South Africa's beloved rugby team, the Springboks, was touring the U.S., and a number of demonstrators had converged in the terminal area, proclaiming that these goodwill exchanges should cease until apartheid was ended.

"There were legal protests going on," one FBI agent recalled to AMW. "A lot of the people were simply there because of their opposition to apartheid. But Donna Borup inserted herself into this group of demonstrators to inflict some real damage."

Interestingly, news reports about the Springboks tour had listed the wrong schedule. When the protestors showed up, the team was not there. Nonetheless, the demonstrators shouted slogans. According to authorities, Borup was determined to enflame the tensions in ways that many in the crowd couldn't anticipate.

"There was not a riot going on," the FBI agent said. "She had violence on her mind. She'd brought a vial of acid to the airport and, when she saw the opportunity, threw it in the face of Officer Goodstein."

The corrosive liquid blinded the lawman, ending his career. Borup was arrested on charges of first-degree assault, but disappeared before she could be tried.

"She has never expressed remorse," the agent said, "never described this as a youthful indiscretion. This is not a woman who feels sorry for what she did."

Authorities believe Borup may be working as an artist and cultivating relationships in the gay and lesbian community.

The story did not generate much media attention because it occurred during a time of social unrest; at least two bombs were detonated during the Springboks tour.

A month later, the so-called Black Liberation Army (BLA) attempted to subsidize its activities by robbing an armored truck in Nanuet, N.Y., north of New York City. In the violent robbery, two police officers and a Brinks private security guard were killed.

A number of participants in these types of incidents were assisted by other members of their network in escaping to Cuba, which refused to extradite the fugitives.

Among these celebrity guests of the Castro regime were BLA member Joanne Chesimard, convicted of the murder of New Jersey State Trooper Werner Foerster during a traffic stop; FALN bomb maker William Morales; and Cheri Dalton, accused of aiding Chesimard's escape and robbing a Brinks truck in 1983. As recently as 2008, Dalton was featured in a British newspaper, talking about her role promoting hip-hop in Havana.

Authorities believe that Borup may have visited these fugitives in Cuba. She always maintained secrecy, and the FBI JTTF theorizes that she's either living in the United States or Canada, where could have worked as an artist, and has cultivated friendships in the gay and lesbian communities.

She may also have traveled with Elizabeth "Danielle" Anna Duke, who was profiled on AMW in 2004 for her involvement in a bombing ring.

Leo Frederick Burt is wanted for allegedly participating in the bombing of Sterling Hall, on the campus of the University of Wisconsin, on August 24, 1970. The blast from the explosion, combined with the fire, resulted in the death of a 33-yearold researcher. Additionally, there were several injuries reported and an estimated \$6 million damage to the building and its contents. Reportedly, explosives had been placed in a stolen panel truck, located three blocks from the building, just several days before the blast. Also, a light-colored, late-model vehicle (Corvair) was seen leaving the vicinity of the bombing, and Burt was identified as being in the car.

On September 2, 1970, Leo Burt was indicted federally in Madison, Wisconsin. He was charged with sabotage, destruction of government property, and conspiracy.

fugitive from the law. Bridgeforth is balding and wore eyeglasses or contact lenses. He has been known to travel internationally, including Algeria, Guinea, Morocco, Ghana,

Tanzania, France, Belize, and Zimbabwe.

CAUTION

Ronald Stanley Bridgeforth is wanted for his alleged involvement in attacks on law enforcement officials in California, including the August 29, 1971, attack on San Francisco's Ingleside Police Station in which a Police Sergeant was shot and killed. Law enforcement investigation determined that this act of violence was committed by members of an extremist group known as the Black Liberation Army (BLA). The BLA had undertaken a series of attacks on police targets consisting of shootings, bombings, and attempted bombings beginning in the late 1960s and continuing through the 1970s. These attacks resulted in the deaths of several police officers around the nation.

Bridgeforth was alleged to be a member of the BLA and was detained on November 5, 1968, in South San Francisco after attempting to purchase merchandise with a stolen credit card. During questioning, Bridgeforth pulled out a revolver and fled the area. A pursuit ensued, followed by a gun battle in which Bridgeforth was wounded. He was taken into custody and charged with attempt to kill a public official and assault on a police officer with a deadly weapon. He pled guilty to these charges and was ordered to appear in court for sentencing on April 11, 1969. Bridgeforth failed to appear for sentencing and a bench warrant was issued for his arrest. A federal arrest warrant was issued in the United States District Court, Northern District of California, San Francisco, California, on June 18, 2004, charging Bridgeforth with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution.

Additionally, on January 18, 2007, California state arrest warrants were issued for Bridgeforth charging him with murder and conspiracy to murder police officers based on the multiple attacks/murders and bank robberies committed by the BLA, and in connection with the 1971 attack on the Ingleside Police Station allegedly committed by Bridgeforth and other members of the BLA.

Norberto Gonzalez-Claudio is allegedly a member of a clandestine Puerto Rican terrorist group which has claimed responsibility for armed robberies and terrorist bombings. A federal arrest warrant was issued on August 23, 1985, in Hartford, Connecticut, charging Norberto Gonzalez-Claudio with obstruction of commerce by robbery and conspiracy. Another federal arrest warrant was issued on March 21, 1986, in New Haven, Connecticut, charging Gonzalez-Claudio with bank robbery, aggravated robbery, theft from interstate shipment, foreign and interstate transportation of stolen money, and conspiracy to interfere with commerce by robbery.
