Introduction by Cliff Kincaid:

My book *Marxist Madrassas* (published in 2016) explained that it is significant that the so-called International Solidarity Movement (ISM) has found a base on many college campuses and sponsored the BDS (boycotts, divestment, and sanctions) economic warfare campaign against Israel. We added, “Jewish students tend to be targets in these campaigns and have been threatened and assaulted.”

What we warned about has come to pass in a dramatic manner. Anti-Semitism is on the rise, not only in colleges and universities but globally, largely because of the propaganda campaigns and support from a nuclear-armed Russia and its client state Iran, now on the verge of attaining nuclear weapons.

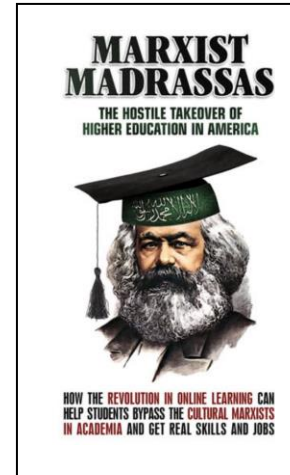
Our book, *Red Jihad: Moscow's Final Solution for America and Israel*, is more relevant than ever before. The destruction of Israel and the systematic annihilation of the Jews worldwide are on the international agenda. We will see United Nations demands for Israel to abandon its nuclear deterrent.

America’s Survival, Inc. documented this problem years ago but we were heavily censored by YouTube and de-funded. We need your help to continue our research.

In our 2011 report, “The International Solidarity Movement: Threat to America, Israel and the World,” by Lee Kaplan, we noted that the International Solidarity Movement “involves heavy use of American radicals and leftists and exploits the U.S. educational system, particularly American colleges, to delegitimize the democratic State of Israel, a U.S. ally. At the same time, it provides support for groups such as Hamas that use armed violence and terrorism against Israel.”

The modern roots of the anti-Semitic movement can be found in Russia. The *Protocols of Learned Elders of Zion* is a Russian forgery used by Nazis and Communists to generate hatred of the Jews and Israel and is cited as authoritative in the charter of Hamas. This anti-Semitic document drives much of the anti-Israel sentiment in the world today.

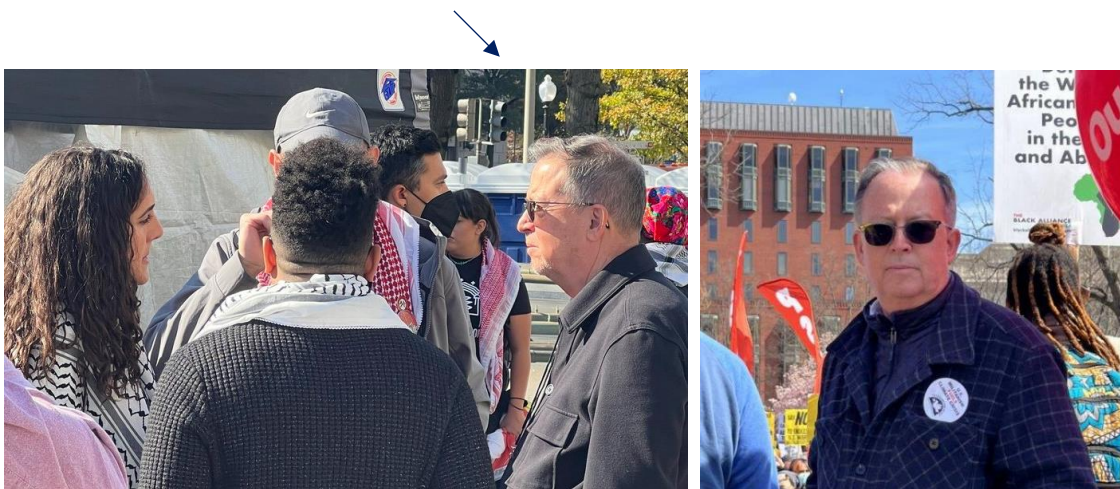
Communists organized the national march to “Free Palestine” on November 4 in Washington, D.C. which drew more than 100,000 people. It was described as the largest “pro-Palestinian” rally in U.S. history. But major media coverage was inaccurate and misleading. It was in fact a pro-communist event arranged by many of the same people who organized the anti-Ukraine rally in Washington, D.C. on March 18. They serve the interests of Russia, China, Iran, and North Korea.



In our report, **“Communists and Muslims: The Hidden Hand of the KGB,”** former KGB officer Konstantin Preobrazhensky noted, “The communists have considered Islam their ally from the very beginning because in the early 20th century Islam was the religion of the ‘oppressed people,’ of the ‘oppressed nations.’ Support of Islam was considered part of Russian-based anti-colonialism. It is very significant that Vladimir Lenin in 1917 addressed his second message to the ‘Muslim toilers of Russia and the Whole World.’ So they considered Muslims a reservoir of people for the world communist revolution.”

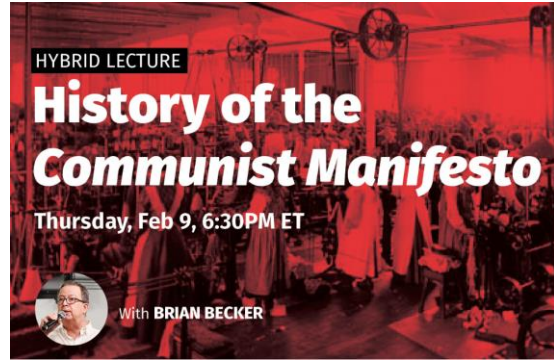


Key organizers of the “Free Palestine” rally included communist Brian Becker (below) of the Marxist-Leninist Party for Socialism and Liberation (PSL). Becker used to be a leader of the Workers World Party. A split led to the creation of the PSL. He was also a key organizer of the anti-Ukraine rally in Washington, D.C. on March 18, 2023.



A frequent guest on Russia Today, a Russian propaganda channel, he has been interviewed by the Chinese newspaper *Global Times*, where he praised dictator Xi and the Chinese Communist Party (CCP). He hosted a show on Radio Sputnik, a Russian propaganda operation, and a podcast called “The Socialist Program.” Sputnik registered as a foreign agent of Russia. His career in the communist movement includes strong support for the Stalinist North Korea dictatorship, even meeting with North Korea officials to praise their regime.

In contrast to the YouTube censorship of my group, Becker has a YouTube video in honor of the Communist Manifesto, the Mein Kampf of the communist movement, and has an account on “X,” formerly Twitter. The video shows him speaking on “Red Books Day” to a mostly young audience.



As a result of my work, I have appeared on the “extremist” list maintained by the Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC), a group that maintains millions of dollars in offshore bank accounts and which smears opponents of communism and radical Islam. SPLC personnel signed a statement by “Writers Against the War on Gaza” blaming the Jewish state for provoking Hamas’s terrorist attacks that killed 1,400 Israelis.



I also appeared on a Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) list of people “guilty” of “Islamophobia.”

Referring to this kind of targeting by the SPLC and CAIR, Karl Zinsmeister of the Philanthropy Roundtable writes, “Taking people and groups with political views different from your own and lumping them with villains and gangsters is the mark of a bullying organization that aims to intimidate and even criminalize philosophical opponents.”

We will not be intimidated.

To understand the Middle East problem historically, as Russian defectors have explained, the communists in Moscow came up with the name, Palestine Liberation Organization, in the same way they devised various “liberation movements” for other parts of the Western world.

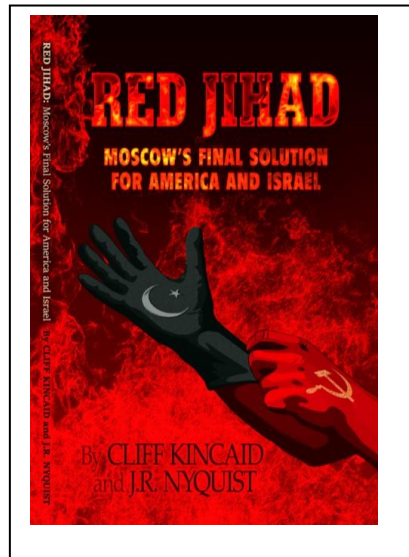
For example, the communists consider the American territory of Puerto Rico “occupied” and subject to “liberation.” As a result, the Puerto Rican FALN’s 140 bombings included the January 24, 1975, lunchtime attack on Fraunces Tavern in

New York City, which killed four innocent people. (Fraunces Tavern is where General Washington bid farewell to his officers after the American victory in the Revolutionary War.)

President Obama commuted the federal sentence of FALN terrorist leader and founder Oscar Lopez Rivera.

Former KGB officer Konstantin Preobrazhensky is not alone in charging that PLO chairman Yasser Arafat was a Soviet KGB agent. Lt. Gen. Ion Mihai Pacepa, the highest-ranking official ever to have defected from the former Soviet bloc, makes the same charge. Pacepa said he saw the KGB's file on Arafat, proving that he was Egyptian and that he was trained by Moscow to make the cause of "Palestine" into one that would unite anti-Zionists and anti-Americans around the world.

Our book, *Red Jihad: Moscow's Final Solution for America and Israel*, cites substantial evidence of Russian involvement with the Jihadists targeting Israel, Europe and the United States.



Our 2014 book, *Back from the Dead: The Return of the Evil Empire*, exposes how the fall of the Berlin Wall misled many into thinking the Soviet KGB was dead. But infiltration of the West continued while the KGB, now called the FSB, looted Russia, consolidated its power, and rebuilt the Russian military, including its nuclear forces.



The Al Aqsa Flood is the name for the terrorist attacks on Israel that initiated the 2023 Israel– Hamas war. The phrase "From the River to the Sea" is meant to symbolize Hamas control over the entire territory of Israel's borders, from the Jordan River to the Mediterranean Sea. The "martyrs" are dead terrorists.





Burning tires represent the first Intifada or “uprising” in the late 1980s. The character on the right represents Black Lives Matter, a Marxist group blamed for demonizing and encouraging the murder of local police. It, too, is very active on college campuses and had joined the campaign against Israel, declaring the country is guilty of “genocide” and that, through foreign aid to Israel, Americans are made “complicit in the abuses committed by the Israeli government.”

Of these groups, the New York-based People’s Forum is significant in the communist realm, for it offers a course on Vladimir Ilyich Ulyanov, more commonly known as Lenin, described in course materials as “a well-loved revolutionary across countries and movements, whose name embodies the spirit of working-class internationalism.”

The People's Forum is directly linked to the Party for Socialism and Liberation and is financed by millionaire Neville "Roy" Singham, an American businessman based in China.

The Congress once investigated communist groups supporting foreign enemies. But that is now considered unacceptable. We at America's Survival have stepped into the void.

Another individual endorsing the rally came from the National Lawyers Guild (NLG), an old Communist Party front. The Guild has more than 100 chapters in American law schools and its membership includes many law professors.



The National Lawyers Guild issued a statement after the massacre saying it "stands in solidarity with the people of Palestine in their struggle against the settler colonial state of Israel and calls on our members and allies throughout the United States and around the globe to stand and act in support of that struggle."

Honest liberal law professor Alan M. Dershowitz has commented, "The Guild has never abandoned its Marxist-Leninist provenance."
