BIOS

A veteran journalist and media critic, **Cliff Kincaid** concentrated in journalism and communications at the University of Toledo, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree, and came to Washington through a national journalism program headed by conservative author and journalist M. Stanton Evans. At his college newspaper, Cliff won an award for editorial writing from the Society of Professional Journalists. In addition to serving as President of America's Survival, Inc. (ASI), he is the director of the Accuracy in Media (AIM) Center for Investigative Reporting. He has

written or co-authored nine books on foreign policy, the media and cultural affairs.

America's Survival, Inc. specializes in exposing the United Nations, international organizations and extremist movements. ASI was the first national organization to warn of global taxes and the proposed International Criminal Court, holding news conferences on these matters at the National Press Club and on Capitol Hill. ASI has been warning of world government financed by global taxes for over 15 years. ASI President Cliff Kincaid wrote the books, *Global Bondage* (1995) and *Global Taxes for World Government* (1997).

Other activities have included:

- Releasing the 600-page FBI file on Frank Marshall Davis, President Obama's childhood communist mentor, and FBI files on such figures as Howard Zinn and Bella Abzug.
- Exposing the illegal practice of the Clinton Administration diverting money from the Department of Defense budget to U.N. peacekeeping.
- Exposing the role of then-U.N. Secretary-General Kofi Annan in brokering a Clinton Administration deal with Libya in the Pan Am 103 terrorism case.
- Urging law enforcement authorities to continue investigating Bill Ayers and Bernardine Dohrn for their alleged roles in the 1970 bombing murder of San Francisco Police Sergeant Brian V. McDonnell.
- Opposing acceptance of Al-Jazeera and other foreign propaganda channels in U.S. media markets.

ASI is currently working to re-establish congressional committees or subcommittees to investigate internal security problems. Kincaid has met with Reps. Peter King and Phil Gingrey to ask that the House Homeland Security Committee investigate international Marxist collusion with radical and revolutionary Islam as well as the activities of foreign propaganda channels Al-Jazeera, Russia Today (RT) television, and Iranian Press TV on American soil.

Pamela Geller is the founder, editor and publisher of Atlas Shrugs.com, and the executive director of Freedom Defense Initiative (FDI)/Stop Islamization of America (SIOA). She is a regular columnist for Andrew Breitbart's Big Government and Big Journalism, the American Thinker, and other publications. Pamela Geller is the author of the book *The Post-American Presidency: The Obama Administration's War on America* with Robert Spencer (foreword by Ambassador John Bolton), published by Simon & Schuster. Pamela Geller is the 2010 recipient of the Annie Taylor Award for Courage, presented by the David Horowitz Freedom Center. Geller has broken numerous important stories -- notably the questionable and illegal foreign sources of some of the financing of the Obama campaign, the anti-Semitic posts on Obama's website, Obama's political organizing in public school classrooms, ACORN's destruction of Republican voter registrations, and many more. A frequent guest on radio and television, she was the subject of a profile on 60 Minutes and has been profiled in a cover story in the Sunday New York Times Metro section.

Charles K. Ortel serves as Managing Partner of Newport Value Partners, L.L.C. Newport, established in 2007, provides value-added research to executives and to investment firms. Ortel has been warning that many initiatives launched by the Obama Administration seem to constitute a "War on Capitalism". In October 2010, Ortel noted that political conditions inside the U.S. seemed unusually polarized and unlikely to be resolved in a business-friendly way for years. Citing a daunting array of external threats, Ortel has been suggesting that investors reduce long exposures to securities and consider increasing allocations to strategies that trade volatility and are short-based. Raised in Manhattan, Ortel graduated from Harvard Business School with an M.B.A. in 1980, from Yale with a B.A., cum laude in 1978 and from Horace Mann School, cum laude, in 1974.

Jerry Kenney is an independent television producer from Port Orange, Florida and a graduate of Daytona State College. He uncovered the illegal relationship of MHz Networks, a division of Commonwealth Public Broadcasting, with 30 public TV stations around the country, whereby they air Al-Jazeera and Russian Today television. Kenney subsequently hired a lawyer to file a complaint with the Federal Communications Commission, arguing that the contracts between the public TV stations and Commonwealth violate federal rules. In effect, the public TV stations are being improperly used for the purpose of broadcasting foreign propaganda in the U.S. Violations of the rules can result in financial fines and revocation

of broadcast licenses. His company, Kenney Broadcasting Corporation, provides video services to the travel industry in Florida and has produced political television ads for Democratic State House and Republican candidates and office holders. Jerry volunteers the use of his Cessna 172 airplane and his time as a pilot to patients in need of out-of-area medical treatment.

Lee Kaplan is an investigative journalist who has been published internationally. He has been a contributor to Front Page Magazine, a regular columnist for the Israel National News and Canada Free Press, and is a senior intelligence analyst and communications director for the Northeast Intelligence Network. His columns also appear at the International Analyst Network, Campus Watch, and many other websites. He heads the organizations Defending America for Knowledge and Action (DAFKA) and Stop the ISM. He has been interviewed on over two hundred nationally and internationally syndicated radio shows in the United States and Israel and been a guest on the Fox News Channel. He is a regular guest on the Jim Kirkwood Show on Utah's K-Talk Radio am 630 where he discusses Homeland Security issues, the War on Terror and Geopolitics. A graduate of UCLA, he is a member of the Bruin Alumni Association and the UCLA Alumni Association. A U.S. correspondent for the Israel Resource News Agency in Jerusalem, he currently writes editorials for Isracampus.org.il and is an Associate of Israel-Academia-Monitor.com as well as a Fellow at the American Center for Democracy. He is currently working on a book about America's colleges in the War on Terror and the International Solidarity Movement.
