## The World Federalists Were on the Wrong Side of the Cold War

Citizens for Global Solutions, formerly known as the World Federalist Association, is a member of the World Federalist Movement (WFM). <sup>2</sup> The organization was so concerned about the negative connotations of being associated with the terms “world federation” or “world government” that it changed its name.



During the historic stand-off between the U.S. and the Soviet Union, the World Federalist Association (WFA) was on the wrong side, collaborating with the Soviet Peace Committee, an instrument of the Soviet Communist regime. The WFA staged a “Mission to Moscow” and held several meetings with the Soviet Peace Committee for the purpose of “discussing the goal of general and complete disarmament” and “the strengthening of the United Nations.” At the time, the Soviets were trying to defeat the Reagan conventional and nuclear arms build-up and policy of supporting anti-Communist freedom fighters.

In particular, the WFA and its officials strongly opposed the policy of

assisting Nicaraguan freedom fighters who were opposing the Soviet- and Cuban-backed Nicaraguan Sandinista dictatorship. A suit filed by the WFA with the U.N.'s International Court of Justice had declared U.S. support of the freedom fighters, known as "Contras," to be a violation of international law.

If the U.S. had complied with this dictate, Nicaragua would have remained a Communist dictatorship and Communism could have taken over all of Central America. But the Reagan policy forced the Sandinistas into holding free elections that the Communists lost. This defeat led to the Communists in El Salvador giving up their armed struggle and making peace with the government.

### **Growing the U.N. to Diminish U.S. Power**

**The WFA wants to transform the United Nations into a global state with independent military, police and judicial powers. One of its main priorities is "To provide the U.N. with sustained and independent sources of funding."**

In the WFA booklet, "The Genius of Federation: Why World Federation is The Answer to Global Problems," the group describes how the Law of the Sea Treaty and the International Criminal Court (ICC) are both important steps on the road to world government. It says that a "world federation," a euphemism for world government, can be achieved by advancing "step by step toward global governance, using the U.N....Let the U.N. establish new agencies such as an International Criminal Court (which can try individuals for violations of international law) or a U.N. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency..." The booklet goes on to say that **"An organization is already in the process of being developed to control the exploitation of ocean resources,** and similar agencies could be created to govern Antarctica and the moon." (emphasis added). This is a reference to the Law of the Sea Treaty. (see page 12).

By adding more power, authority and functions to the United Nations, it says that, **"national sovereignty would be gradually eroded until it is no longer an issue."**

An official 1997 WFA publication declared:

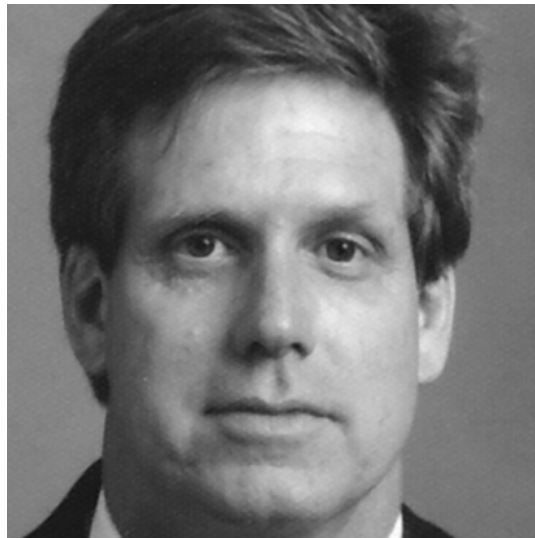
"The final [Law of the Sea] treaty marked real progress in establishing global governance by...stipulating that mining of the seabeds beyond national waters should require payment of royalties to the LOS [Law of the Sea] organization, thereby creating **a funding resource that would be independent of voluntary contributions by the treaty member nations. These are the elements of a limited world government** in a very restricted field that is nevertheless significant." (emphasis added).

The World Federalist Movement (WFM) was a key component of the coalition of U.N.-associated non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that brought the International Criminal Court into existence. They are now working to create a United Nations Emergency Peace Service (UNEPS). A formal proposal for the creation of such a force has been published by the WFM, with support from the Ford Foundation, and an international "Working Group for a U.N. Emergency Peace Service" is seeking to make the proposal into reality. The report predicts that the UNEPS "can be established in the foreseeable future" by working with NGOs in "civil society," as well as "allies in the U.N. and interested governments."

The CGS/WFA believes in the ultimate establishment of a "standing international military force" of 100,000 troops.<sup>3</sup>

Rep. Albert Wynn, the recipient of cash from the CGS PAC, has introduced a bill, H. Res. 180, to create a U.N. peace service. The other co-sponsor is Rep. Jim Leach. Wynn says this U.N. force<sup>4</sup> would include:

- "Two complete mission headquarters, each with military, police, and civilian staff, technical reconnaissance units, light armored reconnaissance squadrons, motorized light infantry, armored infantry, a helicopter squadron, an engineer battalion, and a logistics battalion."
- "10,000-15,000 individuals with a wide range of skills, including civilian police, military personnel, judicial experts, and relief professionals."



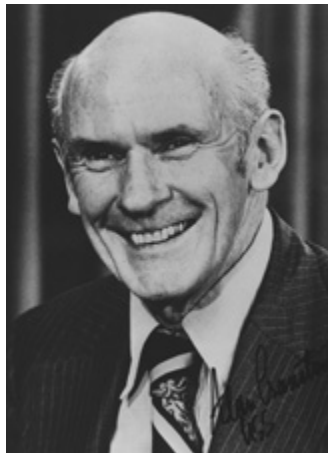
**William Pace of the WFM**

A prominent figure in the WFA was the late **Alan Cranston**, the far-left former California Senator who became chairman of the Gorbachev Foundation, named for the former Soviet President, Mikhail Gorbachev, who leads it. Cranston, himself accused of having a pro-Communist bent, spoke on the subject of a "nuclear-free world" at the twentieth anniversary conference of the

Council for Secular Humanism, which envisions “a future without religion.” Cranston ran for president in 1984 as an outspoken critic of President Reagan.

In his book, *The Sovereignty Revolution*, written shortly before his death, Cranston **described the Law of the Sea Treaty as the “most far-reaching and comprehensive system created thus far by the global community...”** Cranston, who was president of the United World Federalists (1949-52), declared that Article 137 of the treaty contained “a unique provision that elevates sovereignty to a new and unprecedented level. It formally declares that in the open sea and everything beneath it all humanity is sovereign.” In other words, national sovereignty becomes a dead letter and the global community assumes jurisdiction and control.

William Pace, the convenor of the Coalition for the International Criminal Court and executive director of the World Federalist Movement, has savagely attacked the U.S. for attempting to shield Americans from prosecution at the ICC. He is also Secretary-General of the Hague Appeal for Peace, a group whose president, Cora Weiss, gained notoriety for organizing anti-Vietnam War demonstrations and visits to Hanoi to meet with communist leaders. The Hague Appeal for Peace, now in the process of becoming something called Peace Boat-US,<sup>5</sup> was co-sponsored by the World Federalist Movement and a picture of Weiss is included in the 1999 annual report of the WFA. Weiss was the daughter of Samuel Rubin, a reputed member of the Communist Party and a Russian emigre, who founded the Rubin Foundation, which provided the bulk of the initial funding for the pro-Marxist Institute for Policy Studies (IPS).



Senator Alan Cranston

Journalist and author Brian Crozier wrote in *National Review* that IPS was “the perfect intellectual front for Soviet activities which would be resisted if they were to originate openly from the KGB.” S. Steven Powell’s book on IPS, *Covert Cadre*, includes photographs of identified Soviet agents who attended IPS functions or associated with IPS personalities. He names two as KGB officers.

Nevertheless, the WFA was a recipient of \$15,000 in American taxpayer money from the Congressionally-funded U.S. Institute of Peace to analyze the prospect of “standing peace forces and peacekeeping reserves” for the U.N., international tribunals, and a “world court on human rights.”

When the organization was founded in Asheville, North Carolina, in 1947, the local paper headlined the event “World Government Plan Outlined by Speakers.” Today, the World Federalist Movement features strong backing from U.N. Secretary-General Kofi Annan, who says, “Your movement has helped keep alive for fifty years the values which inspire the creation of the United Nations...”

### **Hillary Clinton and the WFA**

Senator Richard Lugar, chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, receives PAC money from the World Federalists and is praised by them for leading the campaign to ratify the Law of the Sea Treaty. The WFA also featured then-First Lady and now-Senator Hillary Rodham Clinton in a video-taped address on October 19, 1999. Mrs. Clinton spoke to the group in the context of commending Walter Cronkite, the former anchorman of the CBS Evening News, and the WFA. Cronkite, who received the WFA’s 1999 global governance award, declared that “we must strengthen the United Nations as a first step toward a world government” and that America must “yield up some of our sovereignty.”



**WFA Favorite Senator Clinton**

In accepting the award, Cronkite, who became an official spokesman for the WFA after he stepped down as anchorman of the CBS Evening News, revealed that he had been asked to serve as a “Washington lobbyist” and spokesman for the world federalists when he began his journalistic career 50 years ago. In his book, *A Reporter’s Life*, Cronkite declared that “a system of world government” was “mandatory” and that “proud nations someday will see the light and, for the common good and their own survival, yield up their precious sovereignty...”

Mrs. Nane Annan, the Swedish wife of the U.N. Secretary-General, actor Michael Douglas, and then-WFA President John B. Anderson, the former congressman, were among those honoring Cronkite at the WFA event.

Cronkite also called for passage of several U.N. treaties, including:

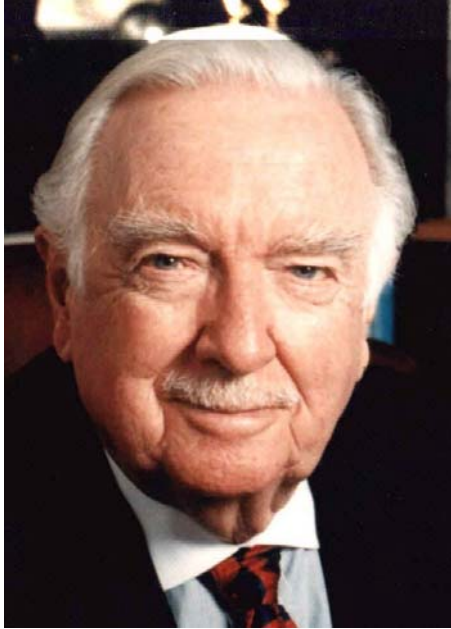
- The treaty to ban land mines
- The Law of the Sea Treaty;
- The Comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban Treaty;
- The Convention to Eliminate All Forms of Discrimination Against Women;
- The Convention on the Rights of the Child; and
- The treaty for a permanent International Criminal Court.

In his own message to the group, dated June 22, 1993, Bill Clinton noted that Norman Cousins, the WFA founder, had “worked for world peace and world government.” Clinton didn’t disagree with those goals, adding, “Best wishes...for future success.” Clinton’s letter (see page 11) had been sent on the occasion of the WFA’s awarding of a “global governance” award to his Deputy Secretary of State Strobe Talbott, who handled Russian affairs. Talbott, a former columnist for Time magazine, wrote a column entitled “The Birth of the Global Nation,” arguing that in the next century “nationhood as we know it will be obsolete,” that we would all some day become world citizens, and that wars and human rights violations in the 20th century had clinched “the case for world government.” Talbott is now president of the Brookings Institution.

As controversial as the organization itself is Drew J. Asson, its deputy director for government relations, who “coordinates all election-related activities including Global Solutions PAC” and “manages candidates that Citizens for Global Solutions and its affiliated PAC have endorsed and/or supported.” He is also described as “the main contact person on the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea...”<sup>6</sup> He describes himself as someone who assisted in the creation of a “globalist study group in Congress” and wants to “increase the number of globalist members of Congress.”<sup>7</sup>

Asson maintains a blog, which includes material from his work at CGS, where **he says President Bush is a “little fascist” and behaves like “a drunken frat boy.”** The blog<sup>8</sup> also includes such headlines as:

- **ISRAELI FORCES CONTINUE ATROCITIES**
- **BUSH HATES THE CONSTITUTION AND HATES ARABS/LEBANESE**
- **ISRAEL OUT OF CONTROL**
- **GEN. HAYDEN, CIVIL LIBERTIES VIOLATOR EXTRAORDINAIRE, CONFIRMED BY SENATE**



**Cronkite: World government is “mandatory.”**

In the item headlined, BUSH HATES THE CONSTITUTION AND HATES ARABS/LEBANESE, Asson wrote that:

As Lebanon burns, **Bush sits in his emperor's** chair and pontificates. The US won't intervene in the bloodshed in Lebanon as **Israel slaughters innocent civilians** in its quest to kill the terrorist members of Hizbollah. Yes, those terrorists need to be brought to justice and their shower of missiles and bombs on Israel must be condemned day and night. However, Israel's **disproportionate response** and its targeting of civilian infrastructure and innocent Lebanese must be condemned and must be halted. Bush and his royal court refuses to intervene, either because **they love the messianic war being waged or they just don't care**. (emphasis added).

Asson also wrote that:

US Ambassador to the UN John Bolton said that there is no moral equivalence to innocent civilians killed by **Israeli aggression** in Lebanon and Israelis who are killed by Hezbollah terrorists. His implication is that an innocent civilian Israeli life is worth more, morally, than an innocent civilian Lebanese life. This is ridiculous! **Murder is murder**. (emphasis added).

Regarding the Bernie Sanders race for the Senate in Vermont, Asson cited a news article and commented, "...this one is great. It's amazing to see a socialist who's currently a member of the US House of Representatives and the leader in the race to fill the Senate seat being vacated by Jim Jeffords (I-VT). I'm so excited about this race and wish Rep. Sanders the best of luck!"



**Socialist Rep. Bernie Sanders: A Favorite of the World Federalists**

In announcing its endorsed candidates, as well as those it contributes to, CGS says that, "We feel confident that these candidates share CGS' vision, and will work to promote an interconnected, cooperative, and effective state-system..." # The Genius Of Federation: Why World Federation Is The Answer To Global Problems

A Multiplication of Global Functional Organizations. Still another approach is to advance step by step toward global governance, using the U.N. but without trying to amend the Charter. Let the U.N. establish new agencies such as an International Criminal Court (which can try individuals for violations of international law) or a U.N. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency (which can set up a program for arms reduction with verification capabilities and punishments for individuals who try to defy it). An organization is already in the process of being developed to control the exploitation of ocean resources, and similar agencies could be created to govern Antarctica and the moon. The U.N. could be allowed to create its own individually recruited peacekeeping personnel. Peacekeeping operations could be financed through a Peacekeeping Endowment Fund to which multinational corporations and private citizens and non-government organizations could contribute directly without going through national governments. Similar strategies could be adopted for funding environmental programs and population control programs and humanitarian assistance programs and human rights programs. By means of these voluntarily funded functional agencies national sovereignty would be gradually eroded until it is no longer an issue. Eventually a world federation can be formally adopted with little resistance.
