Dear Supporter of America's Survival, Inc.:

Because of our growing influence as an alternative source of news and information, YouTube has removed our martial law video. We have appealed this censorship but are looking for other ways to get our message out. In the meantime, we have to mobilize our resources.

My response to this censorship in the appeal to Google/YouTube was the following:

• This was an educational video about an ad in a major Washington paper on an issue of public interest. There was no harassment or cyber bulling of any kind. It was simply an exchange of views. The headline concerned the position of the individual interviewed in the show. He advocated a popular position. The sponsor of the show is a 501 c 3 educational organization. The person's positions that were controversial were debated and in some cases rejected by the host. Under no circumstances would the host sanction or approve harassment or cyberbulling.

This video was one of several we have done and posted for free over the last critical weeks in our nation's history. Now we have been silenced.

We have been targeted in the past by such groups as the Southern Poverty Law Center and the Council on American-Islamic Relations. Our series of videos on election fraud has been "flagged" by YouTube but this is the first time they have actually deleted one of them under vague warnings of cyberbullying and harassment (see below). It is just another example of the Big Tech censorship many, including the president, have experienced.
