It is the duty of law enforcement officials and school administrator to report to the Department of State Police when a student or other person is determined to pose a clear and present danger to themselves, or to others, within 24 hours of the determination. 20 II. Admin. Code 1230.120,

This form must be completed in its entirety by the law enforcement official, principal, chief administrative officer, or their designee making the determination. Clear and present danger reporting shall be used by the Department of State Police to identify persons who, If granted access to a firearm or firearm ammunition, pose an actual, Imminent threat of substantial bodlly harm to themselves or another person(s) that is articulable and significant or who will likely act in a manner dangerous to public interest.

Completed forms and attachments should be faxed to the Illinois State Police, Firearm Services Bureau at 217/782-9139. For questions or to confirm receipt of a fax, please call the Firearms Services Bureau, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m to 5-00 p.m. at 217/782-3700.
